It is the policy of True Hope Ministries of America and the websites and/or other media operated by True Hope Ministries of America to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our website. This Privacy Policy applies to all True Hope Ministries of America websites (<http://www.truehopeministries.net>; <https://thma.us>; www.thbinst.com) hereinafter collectively identified as "us", "we", "our", or "Website" or "Websites".

We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting personally identifiable information you may provide us through the Website. We have adopted this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") to explain what information may be collected on our Website, how we use this information, and under what circumstances we may disclose the information to third parties. This Privacy Policy applies only to information we collect through the Website and does not apply to our collection of information from other sources.

WEBSITE VISITORS

PROTECTION OF CERTAIN PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION

True Hope Ministries of America discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on True Hope Ministries of America's behalf or to provide services available at True Hope Ministries of America's website, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others.
